Ethernet speed stuck at 100 Mbps is usually caused by a hardware problem: a faulty or low-quality network cable, a faulty Ethernet connector, or a faulty Ethernet LAN socket on the PC or

Problem My gigabit Ethernet speed switches from 1Gbps to 100Mbps frequently. This issue occurs usually, and there is no time pattern in switching

Plug one of the devices that connects at 1Gbit into a socket instead of the device currently connected at 100Mbit. They're both connected to Nvidia shields so they should theoretically be the
