To connect a cable into a lighting distribution box, feed the cable through a designated entry point, secure it with clamps, and connect it to the appropriate terminals inside the box.

Cable Entry and Securing

Lighting distribution boxes are designed with multiple cable entry points to allow flexible installation of incoming and outgoing cables . When feeding a cable into the box:

- o Choose an entry point that aligns with your cable routing plan.
- o Use cable clamps or gland fittings to secure the cable and prevent movement, which reduces strain on the connections and complies with wiring regulations .
- o Ensure the cable insulation is stripped only as needed to expose the conductors for connection, avoiding excessive bare wire exposure.

Internal Connections

- o Identify the phase (live), neutral, and earth terminals for proper connection .
- o Connect the incoming cable conductors to the corresponding terminals, ensuring a tight and secure fit.
- o If the box contains multiple outlets or circuits, route the outgoing cables to their respective terminals or circuit breakers, maintaining organized wiring for easy maintenance .
- o Use terminal blocks or wire connectors to join wires safely, and ensure all connections are insulated to prevent short circuits .

Compliance and Safety

- o Follow local electrical codes and standards, such as IET wiring regulations in the UK, to ensure safe installation .
- o Verify that the main feeder cable can handle the total anticipated load of all connected lighting circuits .
- o After installation, check all connections with a multimeter to confirm continuity and correct voltage before powering the circuits .

- o Keep the distribution box accessible for future maintenance or modifications.
- o Regularly inspect for loose connections, damaged cables, or signs of overheating.
