- o Check Router and Transceivers: Reboot the router, swap transceivers with known-good units, and ensure firmware is up to date .
- o Test Signal Strength: Use a power meter or OTDR to measure optical signal loss; values outside the normal range indicate issues .
- o Contact ISP: If problems persist, provide LOS status and cable observations to your service provider for
