

Can the distribution box be installed on the wall panel

Wall-Mounted Distribution Boxes

Installation Considerations

- o **Structural Support:** The wall must be capable of supporting the weight of the distribution box and its internal components. Use appropriate anchors such as chemical anchors or through-bolts for concrete, and heavy-duty toggle anchors for hollow walls .
- o **Clearances:** Maintain manufacturer-recommended clearances around the box to allow full door opening and safe operation. NEC guidelines require a minimum working space of 30 inches wide, 36 inches deep, and 6.5 feet high in front of the panel .
- o **Accessibility:** The box must remain accessible for maintenance and inspection. NEC Section 314.29 mandates that wiring inside the box cannot be permanently concealed behind walls or finishes; a cover plate or access panel must be provided .
- o **Environmental Protection:** For outdoor or damp locations, select a box with an appropriate IP rating (e.g., IP65 or higher) to protect against dust and water ingress .
- o **Internal Layout:** Mount heavier components lower in the box to improve stability, and plan cable entry points to avoid strain on conductors .

Practical Tips

- o Use vibration dampers if the wall is subject to recurring vibrations.
 - o Ensure all fasteners are torqued according to manufacturer specifications to prevent distortion.
 - o Pre-plan cable entries and use gland plates or flange adapters to maintain ingress protection.
 - o Label all devices during installation and leave sufficient working space for future maintenance .
