Install the Celectrode box capacitor in a secure, accessible location near the equipment it supports, away from excessive heat, moisture, and vibration.

Location Considerations

When selecting a location for the capacitor:

- o Proximity to Equipment: Mount the capacitor close to the system or device it supports to minimize voltage drop and reduce wiring complexity .
- o Accessibility: Ensure the capacitor is easily reachable for inspection, maintenance, or replacement without disassembling other components .
- o Environmental Protection: Avoid areas with excessive heat, cold, moisture, or direct sunlight, as these conditions can degrade capacitor performance and lifespan .
- o Vibration and Movement: Choose a location where the capacitor will not be subjected to strong vibrations or mechanical shocks. Use mounting brackets or hardware to secure it firmly .

Mounting and Connection

- o Secure Mounting: Use the provided brackets or appropriate hardware to attach the capacitor. Ensure it is aligned properly and cannot move or fall during operation .
- o Electrical Connections: Connect the positive and negative terminals to the corresponding power supply wires. Ensure all connections are tight, properly insulated, and free from potential short circuits .
- o Case Grounding: If the capacitor has a case terminal, connect it to ground or earth to reduce electrical noise and enhance safety .

- o Disconnect power before installation to prevent electric shock .
- o Wear protective gear and ensure the area is clear of hazards.
