For complex networks, the switches you use must support a variety of transmission speeds (10, 100, 1000 Mbps), transmission

In a ring network configuration, industrial switches are interconnected in a circular fashion, creating a closed-loop

When configuring a redundant ring, all switches on the same ring must be configured to use the same redundancy protocol. You

As an example, a power company uses B+B SmartWorx Ethernet switches with dual homing and coupling ring

Dual ring topology is a network configuration that uses two concurrent rings of connections to link devices. This
