

Cost of drilling holes in cable tray base plate

o Labor: 10 minutes per hole at \$40/hour

o Tool/consumables: \$0.50 per hole
Estimated cost per hole: Labor: \$6.67 + Tools: \$0.50 = \$7.17 per hole
