Trays can be mounted on walls using cantilever arms or suspended from ceilings with trapeze hangers, depending on the project layout . Use appropriate fasteners: metal anchors for concrete structures or steel clamps for steel frameworks . Supports should typically be spaced 1.5 to 3 meters apart, depending on tray type and load .

Installation Process

Install trays in sections, connecting them with splice plates to maintain alignment and structural integrity . Ensure vertical separation between different types of trays (e.g., 30 cm between power and communication trays) to avoid electromagnetic interference . Lay cables in an organized manner, avoiding excessive bending, and secure them at regular intervals with cable ties or clamps . Label cables clearly for maintenance and future troubleshooting .

Final Checks and Safety

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After installation, verify that all trays are level, straight, and securely fastened. Ensure compliance with local electrical codes and safety standards, including fire-rated penetrations where trays pass through walls or floors . Conduct a final inspection to confirm that cable routing, spacing, and support meet design requirements .
