- o Enclosed Switchgear: Used in industrial settings for medium-voltage distribution, containing switches, breakers, and control devices .
- o Pre-wired Distribution Boxes: Compact units with built-in sockets and breakers, suitable for workshops or temporary setups .

Installation Considerations

- o Safety First: Power must be isolated before installation. Only licensed electricians should handle utility-side connections .
- o Location: Install in an accessible, stable, and code-approved location, protected from flooding or direct water flow .
- o Mounting and Wiring: Secure the enclosure, route supply and load cables properly, terminate connections according to wiring diagrams, and leave enough slack for future maintenance .

- o Weatherproofing: Ensure seals, cable glands, and enclosures are properly installed to prevent water or dust ingress .
- o Future Expansion: Consider potential additions like EV chargers, battery storage, or solar panels when selecting box size .
