An ST to LC multimode fiber patch cord is a high-performance optical cable designed to connect devices in fiber optic networks, featuring ST and LC connectors with multimode fiber for reliable data transmission.

Overview

ST to LC multimode fiber patch cords are fiber optic jumpers with an ST connector on one end and an LC connector on the other, commonly used in telecommunications, data centers, and enterprise networks to interconnect equipment . These cables are available in single-mode and multimode types, with multimode being ideal for short to medium distance applications such as within buildings or campus networks .

Fiber Types and Standards

- o OM1 (62.5/125 μm): Supports 200/500 MHz.km at 850/1300 nm, suitable for legacy networks .
- o OM2, OM3, OM4: Higher bandwidth multimode fibers for faster data rates and longer distances. OM3 and OM4 are optimized for 10G, 40G, and 100G Ethernet .
- o Duplex or Simplex: Duplex cables have two fibers for bidirectional communication, while simplex has a single fiber .

Key Features

- o Low Signal Loss: Insertion loss ≤ 0.3 dB and return loss ≥ 50 dB, ensuring efficient and reliable transmission .
- o Bend Insensitive: Designed to minimize optical loss even when bent or twisted, with a minimum bending radius of 5 cm for OM3 fibers .
- o Wide Compatibility: Compatible with standard fiber optic equipment and connectors, including ST, LC, SC, FC, and E2000 types .
- o Operating Conditions: Typically rated for -20°C to $+75^{\circ}\text{C}$, with LSZH or PVC jackets for indoor use; armored versions are recommended for outdoor or long-distance applications .
- o Customizable Options: Cable length (1m, 2m, 3m, 5m, etc.), jacket color, fiber diameter, and connector polish type (PC, UPC, APC) can be selected based on network requirements .

Practical Considerations

- o Connector Care: Keep dust caps on connectors and patch panels to prevent contamination, which can cause high insertion loss or reflectance .
- o Labeling and Traceability: High-quality patch cords often include identification labels and unique serial numbers for easy management .
