Key Placement Considerations

Proximity to Fiber Entry: The fiber optic box should be installed as close as possible to the point where the fiber enters the building, such as the house connection or building entry point, to minimize cable length and signal loss . **Environmental Protection:** Avoid locations exposed to direct sunlight, moisture, or extreme temperatures. Indoor placement is preferred for protection, but if installed outdoors, ensure the enclosure is weatherproof and shielded from rain or UV exposure . **Accessibility:** Choose a location that allows easy access for future maintenance, testing, or upgrades. Avoid tight or hidden spaces that make it difficult to reach the box or handle the delicate fiber cables . **Wall Mounting:** For indoor installations, mount the box on a stable wall using a level to ensure it is straight. Drill pilot holes, insert anchors, and secure the box with screws. Leave a service loop of 10-15 cm inside the box to prevent stress on the fiber . **Cable Routing:** Route the fiber cable carefully from the entry point to the box, avoiding sharp bends or kinks. Maintain a minimum bend radius (typically 30 mm) to prevent damage to the fiber . Ensure the ONT or router can be connected conveniently from the box location . **Testing and Maintenance:** After installation, test the connection with a fiber power meter or have the service provider verify functionality. Keep the box clean, avoid crushing the cable, and periodically check connections to maintain optimal performance . By following these guidelines, the fiber optic box will provide a reliable, high-speed connection while remaining accessible for maintenance and future upgrades.
