- o Connect the ONT to the Router: Use an Ethernet cable from the ONT's Ethernet port to the router's WAN port .
- o Power On and Configure: Turn on the router and configure settings such as VLAN, DHCP, or PPPoE if required by your ISP.
- o Test the Connection: Verify internet speed and connectivity to ensure optimal performance.

- o Using a compatible router ensures you can fully utilize fiber's high-speed capabilities, including gigabit or multi-gigabit plans .
- o Routers with multiple LAN ports and support for LAN aggregation can further enhance wired network performance .
