

# High-voltage distribution box facing the house

Typical residential distribution lines are considered safe beyond 25-50 feet, and the EMF exposure from a transformer box is minimal if you maintain the recommended clearance . Unlike high-voltage transmission lines, these boxes do not pose significant long-term EMF risks when proper distance is observed.

## Regulatory and Practical Guidelines

- o Clear Working Space: According to electrical codes, high-voltage equipment requires clear working space in front of the box, typically 3-12 feet depending on voltage and configuration .
- o Access for Maintenance: Avoid planting trees or placing structures directly in front of the box to allow utility workers to perform maintenance safely .
- o Child Safety: Warn children not to play near the box and never attempt to open or climb it .
- o Distribution Box Features: Modern boxes may include overload and short-circuit protection, reliable circuit breakers, and insulated enclosures to enhance safety .

## Recommendations

- o Maintain 10 feet of clearance in front and 3 feet on the sides.
- o Avoid landscaping or structures that obstruct access.
- o Educate household members about the dangers of tampering.
- o If concerned about EMF, consider measuring with a gaussmeter for precise exposure levels.
