Understand Layout and Installation Considerations The internal layout affects heat dissipation, cable entry, and wiring space. A well-designed box prevents overcrowding and allows safe maintenance . 7. Verify Standards and Certification Ensure the box meets regional electrical standards and certifications (e.g., CE, CQC, UL) to guarantee safety and reliability .
