

How to make the electrical circuit of the distribution box

Components of a Distribution Box

- o Connect Neutral and Earth Bars: From the RCCB, connect the neutral line to the neutral bus bar and the earth wire to the earth bus bar.
- o Wire Individual MCBs: Connect the phase lines from the RCCB to each MCB in parallel. Each MCB will protect a specific subcircuit, such as lighting, sockets, or appliances .
- o Connect Load Wires: From each MCB, connect the outgoing wires to the respective circuits in the building.
- o Check Connections: Ensure all connections are tight, insulated, and properly labeled for easy identification.
- o Test the System: Use a multimeter to verify voltage, continuity, and proper operation of MCBs and RCCB before powering on .

Safety and Compliance

- o Install the distribution box in a dry, accessible location with good ventilation, typically around 1.5 meters from the floor .
- o Use correct wire gauge and breaker ratings according to the load.
- o Ensure proper grounding to prevent electric shocks.
- o Follow local electrical codes (NEC, IEC, or regional standards) and use certified components.

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o Label all circuits clearly for future maintenance and troubleshooting .
