

How to replace the fiber optic cable

Replacing a fiber optic cable requires careful planning, proper handling, precise termination, and thorough testing to maintain network performance.

Planning and Preparation

Before replacing the cable, conduct a site survey to identify the route, endpoints, and any obstacles such as conduits, ducts, or structural elements. Carefully disconnect the existing fiber from all equipment and patch panels. Label all fibers to ensure correct reconnection. Remove the cable from conduits or trays, avoiding sharp bends or kinks. If the cable is direct-buried, excavate carefully to prevent damage to surrounding infrastructure .

Installation of New Cable

- o Route the new cable through conduits, trays, or ducts, maintaining the recommended bend radius and avoiding twists. For long runs, consider using a "figure 8" pattern on the ground to prevent twisting .
- o Secure the cable using cable ties or clamps without compressing the jacket. Leave extra slack for future maintenance or expansion.
- o Terminate the cable using fusion splicing or mechanical splicing, ensuring connectors are clean and free from contamination. Protect connectors from scratches and dust .

Testing and Verification

After installation, test the fiber using an Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer (OTDR) to check for breaks, bends, or splices causing signal loss. Measure attenuation with an Optical Loss Test Set (OLTS) to ensure the cable meets performance specifications. Document the installation, including cable type, route, splice points,

and test results for future reference .

- o Maintain proper bend radius and avoid excessive tension to prevent long-term degradation.
- o Ensure all connections are properly labeled and organized for easy troubleshooting.
- o Follow industry standards such as ANSI/NECA/FOA-301, TIA/EIA-568, and NEC Article 770 for safety and performance compliance . By following these steps, you can safely replace a fiber optic cable while preserving network integrity and ensuring reliable, high-speed data transmission.
