

How to set up a router with reserved fiber optic cable

Article Overview

A fiber optic cable cannot connect directly to a standard router; it must first pass through an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), which converts the optical signal to Ethernet for the router.

Required Equipment

- o Optical Network Terminal (ONT): Provided by your ISP, this device converts the fiber's light signals into electrical signals your router can use .
- o Fiber-ready router: Ensure your router supports Ethernet WAN input; some routers have SFP ports for direct fiber input .
- o Fiber optic cable: Typically single-mode with SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors .
- o Ethernet cable: Cat6a or higher is recommended to maintain high-speed performance between the ONT and router .

Step-by-Step Connection

- o Install the ONT
 - o Locate the fiber wall outlet where your ISP's fiber line enters your home.
 - o Connect the fiber optic cable from the wall outlet to the ONT's optical port, handling the connector by its plastic housing to avoid contamination or damage .
 - o Power on the ONT and wait for the status lights to stabilize, indicating a successful connection to the ISP network .
- o Connect the ONT to the Router
 - o Use an Ethernet cable to link the ONT's LAN/Ethernet port to the router's WAN port .
 - o Power on the router and wait for the indicator lights to confirm a successful connection.
- o Verify the Connection
 - o Check the ONT's power and status lights; a solid green light usually indicates proper operation .
 - o Test the internet connection on a device connected to the router via Wi-Fi or Ethernet.

Additional Tips

- o Cable Handling: Avoid bending the fiber cable beyond its minimum bend radius to prevent signal loss .
- o Connector Care: Keep protective caps on connectors until ready to connect, and ensure proper alignment when inserting into ports .
- o Placement: Position the ONT and router in a dry, ventilated area near power outlets, ideally protected by a surge suppressor .
