

Installation Method of Cable Tray Slide

Sliding cable trays should be installed following approved layouts, proper support spacing, and safety procedures to ensure alignment, load capacity, and accessibility for cable management.

Preparation and Material Handling

Before installation, inspect all materials for damage and verify they match approved shop drawings and specifications . Store trays horizontally on flat surfaces with timber supports spaced at approximately 1 meter to prevent deformation . When offloading, use cranes or forklifts carefully, ensuring slings or forks do not crush the tray siderails . Only handle single bundles per lift, and cover trays to protect from moisture and sunlight if stored outdoors .

Layout and Planning

Review the approved shop drawings to confirm tray routes, lengths, and mounting heights . Mark the installation path and coordinate with other trades to avoid interference. Install safety barriers and warning signs in the work area before starting . Identify each tray section by feeder name or branch number to maintain organization during installation .

Support and Mounting

Sliding cable trays require center-hung or side-mounted supports to allow movement and accommodate thermal expansion . Maximum support spacing typically ranges from 3.6 meters, with load capacities between 318 kg and 340 kg per hanger . Ensure supports are level and aligned to prevent tray misalignment. Use appropriate fasteners, brackets, and hangers as specified in the design.

Installation Procedure

- o Position the tray sections on the supports, ensuring they can slide freely for thermal expansion or maintenance access .
- o Connect tray sections using approved fittings and hardware, maintaining proper alignment and continuity.
- o Secure grounding connections and verify electrical continuity where required .
- o Inspect each section visually and dimensionally to ensure conformance with approved drawings and standards .
- o Adjust sliding mechanisms if necessary to allow smooth movement without binding.

Safety and Quality Assurance

All personnel should attend safety induction and demonstrate competency in tray installation . Inspect the

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work area for hazards and correct any unsafe conditions before proceeding. Follow QA/QC procedures, including inspection checklists and test plans, to ensure compliance with specifications . Avoid using trays as walkways or supports for personnel, as this can cause injury and damage the system .

Final Checks

After installation, perform a final inspection to verify alignment, support spacing, load capacity, and accessibility for cable installation. Ensure all trays are free to slide as designed and that all fittings, hangers, and grounding connections are secure . Document the installation for QA/QC records and future maintenance reference. By following these steps, sliding cable trays can be installed safely, efficiently, and in compliance with industry standards, ensuring long-term reliability and ease of maintenance.
