Planning and Preparation

- o Install threaded rods and Unistrut channels or other support systems according to approved drawings .
- o Assemble trays using standard fittings, ensuring proper spacing and alignment .
- o Remove burrs and sharp edges to prevent cable damage .
- o Maintain vertical separation between different tray layers (e.g., 30 cm between power and data trays) to avoid interference .

- o Check for clashes with other services and adjust as necessary before final installation .
- o Secure trays firmly using spring knots or clamps to prevent displacement .

Safety and Compliance

- o Follow local electrical codes and standards, including NEMA VE 1 for tray load capacity and material quality .
- o Ensure bonding and grounding of trays to prevent electrical hazards .
- o Use appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) and scaffolding when working at height .
- o Avoid overfilling trays to prevent overheating and maintain accessibility for maintenance .
