Advanced monitoring features allow administrators to view port rates, bandwidth utilization, topology, alarms, and remotely restart ports or upgrade firmware .

Stacking and Scalability: Stackable switches enable unified management of multiple units, with LevelOne supporting stacking of up to 8 physical units and virtual stacking of up to 36 switches, simplifying administration across multi-floor or campus networks .

Security and Reliability: Security features include Dynamic ARP Inspection (DAI) to prevent spoofing attacks, port isolation to enhance network security, and ERPS ring protection with sub-50ms failover for high availability . Storm control and port rate-limiting prevent network congestion caused by broadcast, multicast, or unknown unicast traffic .

Power over Ethernet (PoE): Some switches, like the MEFiberOptic 24-port PoE+ switch, provide up to 30W per port, supporting IP cameras, VoIP phones, and wireless access points, with a total power budget of 300W .
