

One optical splitter for two operators

How It Works

Optical splitters are passive devices that divide a single input optical signal into multiple outputs, allowing multiple users to share the same fiber infrastructure in Passive Optical Networks (PONs) . Standard splitters typically have one input and multiple outputs (1xN), but balanced 2xN splitters have two input fibers and multiple outputs, enabling two separate signals to be distributed simultaneously . This configuration is often used for non-simultaneous redundancy or to allow two operators to share the same splitter infrastructure.

Considerations for Sharing

- o Split Ratio and Signal Loss: Each output receives a fraction of the input power. Sharing a splitter between two operators effectively reduces the optical power available per user, so the split ratio must be carefully chosen to maintain sufficient signal strength .
- o Network Design: Operators must coordinate to ensure that the splitter outputs are allocated properly. For example, a 2x32 splitter can provide 32 outputs per input fiber, allowing each operator to use one input fiber and its corresponding outputs .
- o Insertion Loss: Splitting the signal increases insertion loss, which can limit the maximum distance between the Optical Line Terminal (OLT) and the end-user Optical Network Terminals (ONTs). Using a shared splitter may require higher-power OLTs or shorter fiber runs to maintain performance .
- o Operational Coordination: Since splitters are passive, no power is required, but operators must coordinate maintenance, upgrades, and monitoring to avoid service conflicts .

Practical Applications

- o FTTH Deployments: In dense urban areas, sharing splitters can reduce infrastructure costs by allowing multiple service providers to use the same fiber network .
- o Redundancy and Backup: Two-input splitters can also provide redundancy, where one input serves as a backup for the other, improving network reliability .

A single optical splitter can be used by two operators if a 2xN configuration is employed, with careful attention to split ratios, insertion loss, and coordination between operators.
