A PoE switch self-test involves verifying power delivery to connected devices, checking port functionality, and using either built-in commands or external testers to ensure proper operation.

Using Built-In Switch Commands

For managed switches like Cisco Catalyst 9000 series, you can perform a self-test using CLI commands:

- o Check PoE status per port: Use `show power inline` to see which ports are powered, the allocated power, and the actual power usage .
- o Enable or reset PoE: Commands like `power inline auto` or `shutdown/no shutdown` can re-enable PoE on a port .
- o Verify power budget: Ensure the total PoE allocation does not exceed the switch's available power, leaving 20-30% headroom for stability . These commands help identify ports that are not supplying power due to configuration issues, budget limits, or error-disabled states.

Using External PoE Testers

Portable testers provide a quick and accurate way to validate PoE delivery:

- o LinkSprinter or LinkRunner: These pocket-sized tools measure voltage at the wall jack, test network connectivity, and detect cable faults .
- o TestPro or Network Service Assistant (NSA): These devices allow you to select the PoE standard (802.3af, 802.3at, 802.3bt, UPoE) and perform a PoE Load Test to measure real voltage, current, and power under load .
- o Practical tip: Always test at the endpoint where the powered device (PD) is connected, as voltage drops along the cable can affect actual power delivery .

Manual Device Verification

If you don't have a tester, you can use a known working PoE device:

- o Connect a VoIP phone, access point, or camera to each port.
- o If the device powers on, the port is functioning correctly .
- o Test all ports individually to rule out faulty connections or dust accumulation.

Best Practices

- o Ensure cables are within recommended lengths (≤ 100 meters) and meet category standards (Cat5e/Cat6 for

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higher PoE levels), .

- o Check for compatibility between the switch's PoE standard and the powered device.

- o Document results to track port performance and identify recurring issues. By combining CLI checks, external testers, and endpoint verification, you can effectively perform a PoE switch self-test, ensuring reliable power delivery and network operation.
