A distribution box, also known as a distribution board or breaker box, is an enclosure that distributes electrical power from the main supply to individual circuits, each protected by circuit breakers or fuses. The main switch in a distribution box controls the entire electrical supply, enabling complete disconnection during maintenance or emergencies, and is typically rated for the maximum current capacity of the system .

- o Residential boxes: Typically single-phase, with 6-24 circuits, including pre-installed main switches and standard breakers for lighting, outlets, and appliances .
- o Industrial or hazardous area boxes: Custom-built with stainless steel or explosion-proof enclosures, capable of housing multiple control elements, push buttons, and switches directly on the cover panel .
- o DIN-rail mounted switches: ABB and other manufacturers provide IP-rated switches for DIN-rail installation, suitable for modular setups and smart switchgear applications .
