Common Raw Materials

1. **Galvanized Steel** Galvanized steel is the most cost-effective option for standard indoor applications, such as commercial buildings, data centers, and dry industrial environments. The zinc coating provides basic corrosion protection, while hot-dip galvanization (HDG) is preferred for outdoor or high-moisture areas due to its thicker coating. Mild steel and Q235B steel with a minimum thickness of 1.5mm are commonly used for heavy-duty applications, offering structural strength and durability. Surface treatments like powder coating or electro-galvanization are also applied to enhance corrosion resistance . 2. **Stainless Steel** Stainless steel is used in highly demanding environments, including chemical plants, food and beverage facilities, pharmaceutical manufacturing, and marine applications. It offers superior corrosion resistance, high temperature tolerance (up to 800°F), and long lifespan, though it is 2-4 times more expensive than galvanized steel. Stainless steel trays are ideal for areas exposed to chemicals, saltwater, or extreme conditions . 3. **Aluminum** Aluminum cable trays are lightweight, non-magnetic, and naturally corrosion-resistant, making them suitable for outdoor installations, coastal regions, and applications where weight is a concern. Aluminum alloys like 6063-T5 are commonly used, providing good conductivity and strength. Aluminum trays are approximately 42% lighter than steel but cost around 65% more, offering easier installation and reduced structural load . 4. **FRP (Fiberglass Reinforced Plastic/GRP)** FRP trays are premium, corrosion-resistant solutions used in chemical processing, wastewater treatment, and highly corrosive environments. They are lightweight, non-conductive, and require minimal maintenance, with lifespans of 30-50 years. FRP trays are available in ladder and channel types, providing excellent chemical resistance, UV protection, and fire retardance. However, they have temperature limitations (90-120°F), restricting use in high-heat applications .

Regional Considerations in Southeast Asia

Southeast Asia's tropical climate, high humidity, and coastal exposure make corrosion resistance a critical factor in material selection. Galvanized steel is widely used for indoor and dry environments, while aluminum and FRP are preferred for outdoor, coastal, or chemical-exposed installations. Stainless steel is chosen for high-end industrial projects requiring long-term durability and minimal maintenance .
