Overview

Reducing elbow accessories are specialized cable tray fittings that combine the functions of an elbow (directional change) and a reducer (width adjustment). They are commonly used in ladder, trough, or wire mesh cable trays to navigate corners or obstacles while maintaining proper cable support and organization ().

Key Functions

- o Directional Change: Elbows allow the cable tray to turn 45° or 90° horizontally or vertically.
- o Width Reduction: Reducers adjust the tray width to accommodate different cable volumes or transition between tray sizes.
- o Cable Protection: These fittings prevent cable sagging and reduce stress at bends, protecting cables from mechanical damage.
- o System Integration: They ensure seamless connection between different tray sections, maintaining structural integrity and alignment ().

Materials and Construction

Reducing elbows are typically made from galvanized steel, stainless steel, aluminum, or fiberglass-reinforced plastic (FRP). Material choice depends on environmental conditions, load requirements, and corrosion resistance needs (). For example, pre-galvanized steel is common for indoor ladder trays, while stainless steel is preferred in corrosive or washdown environments ().

Types and Variations

- o Horizontal Reducing Elbows: Change direction along the horizontal plane while reducing width.
- o Vertical Reducing Elbows: Change elevation while reducing width.
- o Left or Right Hand Reducers: Designed for specific directional transitions in complex layouts.
- o Offset Reducing Connectors: Allow slight lateral adjustments while reducing tray width ().

Installation Considerations

- o Ensure the side rail height and tray width match the reducer specifications.
- o Use appropriate splice plates, bolts, and clamps to secure the fitting.

- o Maintain proper bend radius to prevent cable damage.
- o Consider load capacity and spacing of support brackets to avoid sagging ().
