- o **Modularity:** Many boxes feature DIN rails for mounting MCBs, RCDs, and other modular devices. Some systems allow horizontal and vertical expansion or combination of multiple boxes into a seamless system .

Installation Considerations

- o **Mounting:** Surface-mounted boxes are fixed using screws or studs, often with adjustable nuts for precise alignment. Ensure the wall or surface can support the box and its components .
- o **Cable Management:** Pre-stamped knockouts or flange plates allow flexible entry points for cables. Optional accessories like double-row or screwless terminal strips simplify wiring and reduce installation time .
- o **Accessibility:** Boxes with 180° openable covers or hinged doors on both sides facilitate easy access for maintenance and inspection .
- o **Safety:** Ensure busbars and terminals are shrouded, and front cover screws are behind the door to prevent accidental contact . Flame-retardant materials and proper grounding enhance safety.
