The CIF price of a Swiss off-grid power system depends on the system cost, shipping, insurance, and applicable Swiss and destination tariffs, rather than a fixed published rate.

Components Affecting CIF Price

- o **System Cost** The base price of a Swiss off-grid power system includes solar panels, inverters, batteries, and control electronics. Swiss systems are typically high-quality and certified for efficiency and safety, which can increase the initial cost compared to other markets.
- o **Shipping and Freight** CIF (Cost, Insurance, and Freight) includes the cost of transporting the system to the port of destination. - o **Smart Export Guarantee (SEG) Relevance** If the off-grid system is designed to feed surplus energy into a grid in the destination country, SEG-like schemes may influence the economic value of exported electricity. In Switzerland, SEG is not directly applicable, but understanding SEG rates in other countries can help estimate potential revenue from exported energy.
- o **Taxes and Duties at Destination** CIF pricing does not include import duties, VAT, or local taxes, which must be added separately. These vary by country and can significantly affect the total landed cost.

Estimating CIF Price

To estimate a CIF price for a Swiss off-grid system:

- o **Step 1:** Determine the system's ex-factory price in Switzerland.
- o **Step 2:** Add shipping costs to the destination port.
- o **Step 3:** Include insurance premiums for transit.
- o **Step 4:** Factor in any export documentation or certification fees. For example, a 10 kW off-grid solar system might have an ex-factory cost of CHF 25,000-30,000. Shipping and insurance could add 5-10% depending on the destination, resulting in a CIF estimate of CHF 26,250-33,000, excluding import duties and local taxes.

Recommendations

- o Contact Swiss manufacturers or distributors for formal CIF quotations.
- o Specify the destination port and system configuration to get accurate shipping and insurance costs.
- o Consider local incentives or feed-in tariffs in the destination country to evaluate the system's economic viability. By combining these factors, you can calculate a realistic CIF price for Swiss off-grid power systems tailored to your export needs.
