- o Match the module and fiber type to the server or switch port speed (1GbE, 10GbE, 40GbE, 100GbE, 400GbE), .

o Polarity and Wiring:

- o MPO patch cords have Type A, B, and C wiring sequences to ensure correct signal alignment. Proper polarity management is essential for parallel transmission modules like 40G-SR4 or 100G-SR4 .

o Environmental and Material Considerations:

- o Use LSZH jackets for indoor safety and high-grade low-loss glass cores for durability and minimal signal loss .

- o **Compatibility:** Ensure optical modules and patch cords comply with IEEE and MSA standards for

plug-and-play interoperability across brands like Cisco, Huawei, and Ruijie .

- o Patch Panel Integration: High-density fiber patch panels simplify management, reduce rack space, and maintain organized connections. Panels can support 72-216 LC ports per 1-3RU, enabling scalable deployment .
- o Monitoring: Modules with Digital Diagnostic Monitoring (DDM) allow real-time tracking of temperature, voltage, and optical power to maintain network reliability .
- o Future-Proofing: Consider network scaling and potential upgrades when selecting fiber type and module speed to avoid frequent replacements .

Switch/Router Port -> Optical Module (SFP/SFP+) -> Fiber Patch Cord -> Receiving Module -> Target Device . For parallel transmission (40G/100G), MPO patch cords and adapters are used to connect modules to backbone cables while maintaining correct polarity .
