Identifying the Issue

If the breaker trips immediately after resetting, does not switch on, or you notice unusual sounds like buzzing or crackling, it is likely faulty or there is a deeper wiring issue . In such cases, contact a licensed electrician to inspect and replace the breaker or repair the panel safely.

Additional Considerations

- o Ensure the main power supply to the distribution box is active and sufficient for the connected circuits .
- o Avoid overloading circuits by redistributing appliances or upgrading the panel if necessary .
- o Hidden GFCI outlets or failed outlets can also prevent power even if the breaker appears on, so check these if only part of the home is affected . By following these steps, you can safely determine why the breaker was not switched on and restore power while minimizing the risk of electrical hazards.
