The electricity meter is installed upstream in a separate meter box, ensuring accurate recording of total energy consumption before power is divided among circuits . Some modern DB boxes may include optional energy monitoring units or smart modules, but these are not standard for basic distribution boxes .

- o **Billing and Utility Access:** Since the meter is separate, the utility company reads energy usage from the meter box, not the distribution box.
- o **Safety and Maintenance:** The distribution box allows safe access for circuit management and maintenance without interfering with metering .
- o **Legal Compliance:** Electrical codes typically require meters to be installed in a dedicated meter box; having a distribution box without a meter is standard and compliant in most residential and commercial setups .
