

What does 1x12 core armored optical cable mean

- o Long-term reliability: Armored cables are preferred where cables may be exposed to crushing, vibration, or rodent damage.

Additional Notes

- o These cables can be single-mode (OS2) or multi-mode (OM1, OM2, OM3, OM4) depending on the required bandwidth and distance .
- o Armored cables are more robust than standard fiber optic cables, allowing installation without additional conduit in many outdoor or industrial scenarios .
