

What is a flat ground wire in a cable tray

A flat ground wire in a cable tray is a safety conductor that provides a low-impedance path for fault currents, connecting the tray and its cables to the facility's grounding system.

Definition and Purpose

A flat ground wire, often referred to as an Equipment Grounding Conductor (EGC), is a metallic conductor installed along or within a cable tray to safely carry stray electrical currents to the ground. Its primary purpose is safety: it prevents electrical shocks, reduces the risk of fire, and protects equipment from damage caused by electrical faults or surges. By providing a continuous path to the earth, it ensures that any fault current triggers protective devices like circuit breakers, stopping the flow of electricity quickly.

Design and Installation

Flat ground wires are typically bare or insulated copper conductors that run parallel to the cable tray. They are mechanically and electrically bonded to the tray sections using grounding clamps or connectors, ensuring continuity across the entire tray system. In some installations, the cable tray itself can serve as the grounding path, but using a dedicated flat ground wire is often preferred for low impedance and enhanced safety, especially in facilities with sensitive equipment or high fault currents. Key installation considerations include:

- o Material compatibility: Avoid bare copper in aluminum trays to prevent electrolytic corrosion; insulated conductors with exposed bonding points are recommended.
- o Low resistance: The grounding path should have minimal resistance (ideally 4 ohms or less) to ensure effective fault current diversion.
- o Mechanical stability: Ground wires are anchored to prevent displacement under magnetic forces during fault conditions.
- o Compliance: Installation must follow local and international electrical codes, such as NEC requirements for EGCs and cable tray grounding.
