

What is an OLT optical cable

Optical cables in an OLT connect the central office to multiple subscriber endpoints, transmitting high-speed data over fiber in a Passive Optical Network (PON).

Role of Optical Cables in OLTs

Optical cables are the primary medium through which an OLT communicates with Optical Network Units (ONUs) or Optical Network Terminals (ONTs) at subscriber premises. The OLT converts electrical signals from the service provider's backbone into optical signals, which are transmitted through these fibers to splitters and then to multiple end-users, enabling high-speed internet, voice, and video services .

Types of Optical Cables

- o Single-mode fiber (SMF): Most commonly used in OLT deployments due to its long-distance transmission capability (up to 20 km or more) and low signal attenuation .
- o Multi-mode fiber (MMF): Less common in OLTs, typically used for shorter distances within buildings or data centers.

Connection Interfaces

OLT ports often use SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) or SFP+ modules to interface with optical cables. Each module is designed for specific Tx (transmit) and Rx (receive) wavelengths, ensuring proper bidirectional communication with ONUs/ONTs . Some OLTs support dual-mode XPON SFPs, allowing compatibility with GPON, XGS-PON, or other PON standards .

PON Port and Splitter Considerations

Each OLT PON port can drive a single PON network, which is then split to serve multiple subscribers. Typical split ratios range from 1:32 to 1:128, depending on the PON standard and network design . Optical cables from the OLT connect to passive splitters in the Optical Distribution Network (ODN), which then distribute the signal to individual ONUs/ONTs.

Deployment and Management

Proper cable management is critical in central offices to avoid signal loss and maintain network reliability. OLTs are usually installed in racks with organized fiber trays, and optical cables are routed carefully to minimize bending and stress. High-quality connectors (LC or SC) are used to ensure low insertion loss and stable connections .
