

What is the appropriate size for a three-level distribution box

Depth may vary slightly for high-amperage panels or when additional devices like surge protectors or smart home modules are included.

- o Material: Typically metal (sheet steel) or high-impact plastic, affecting internal volume slightly.
- o Wire Capacity: Depth and internal volume are critical to accommodate multiple conductors without overcrowding, ensuring compliance with wire fill rules .
- o Customization: Some manufacturers offer modular or pre-wired three-level boxes with adjustable internal layouts to suit specific project requirements. In practice, always verify the manufacturer's datasheet for exact dimensions and ensure the selected box meets local electrical codes and installation standards.
