

Article Overview

An indoor electrical distribution box safely distributes power from the main supply to multiple circuits using MCBs, RCCBs, and proper wiring practices.

Components of a Distribution Box

An indoor distribution box typically contains:

- o Main MCB (Double Pole): Acts as the main switch, controlling the entire supply.
- o Single-Pole MCBs: Protect individual branch circuits for lighting, outlets, or appliances.
- o RCCB (Residual Current Circuit Breaker): Provides protection against earth leakage and electric shock.
- o Busbars and Terminal Connectors: Facilitate organized wiring and connection of neutral and earth wires ().

Placement and Preparation

- o Install the box in a dry, ventilated, and accessible location, typically around 1.5 meters above the floor for residential setups ().
- o Ensure enclosure protection (IP or NEMA rating) to prevent dust or moisture ingress.
- o Leave sufficient space around the box for maintenance and future expansion ().
- o Cut off the main power supply and verify with a multimeter before starting any wiring ().

Wiring Steps

- o Connect the Main Supply:
 - o Connect the incoming phase and neutral wires to the main MCB.
 - o Ensure the main MCB rating matches the total load (commonly 63A for domestic use) ().
- o Branch Circuit Connections:
 - o Connect each branch circuit to a single-pole MCB.
 - o Phase wires go to the MCB input, and output wires go to the respective load circuits.
 - o Neutral wires are connected to the neutral busbar, and earth wires to the earth busbar ().
- o RCCB Installation:
 - o Connect the main supply to the RCCB input if used.
 - o Branch circuits are connected to the RCCB output to provide leakage protection.
 - o Ensure correct polarity and test the RCCB after installation ().
- o Cable Management:

- o Use proper wire gauge according to load requirements.
- o Keep wires neat, insulated, and secured with cable ties.
- o Label each circuit for easy identification during maintenance ().
- o Testing:
 - o Perform visual inspection and continuity tests.
 - o Use a multimeter to verify voltage and ensure no short circuits.
 - o Test MCBs and RCCB operation before powering the system ().

- o Always wear insulating gloves and safety glasses.
- o Avoid working on live circuits.
- o Follow local electrical codes (NEC, IEC, or regional standards).
