

Wiring method for one-way distribution boxes

Article Overview

A one-way distribution box is typically wired using a five-wire system: three-phase lines (A, B, C), one neutral, and one ground, with connections made to circuit breakers and busbars according to load requirements.

Wire Configuration

For a standard one-way distribution box, the incoming power line usually follows a five-wire system:

- o Phase lines (A, B, C): Typically colored yellow, green, and red.
- o Neutral line (N): Light blue.
- o Ground line (PE): Yellow with green stripes . For single-phase 220V loads, use one phase line, one neutral, and one ground. For three-phase 380V loads, all three phase lines plus neutral and ground are used. Special two-phase 380V equipment can use any two-phase lines with a ground wire .

Circuit Breaker Connections

- o 1P (single-pole) breakers: Connect the live (phase) wire to the breaker terminal; the neutral bypasses the breaker and connects directly to the neutral busbar .
- o 2P (double-pole) breakers: Both live and neutral wires are connected to the breaker, which disconnects both simultaneously when tripped .
- o Protective Earth (PE): Connect to the ground busbar; for breakers with RCDs, connect the PE to the dedicated terminal . Each branch circuit should have its own breaker, and wiring should follow the left-to-right arrangement inside the box, with incoming wires on the left and outgoing wires on the right .

Wire Sizing and Color Coding

- o Lighting and socket circuits: Typically 2.5 mm² wires.
- o Air conditioning or higher-load circuits: 2.5 mm² or 4.0 mm² wires depending on load .
- o Wire color coding: Phase A - yellow, Phase B - green, Phase C - red, Neutral - blue, Ground - yellow/green .

Installation and Safety Practices

- o Fix the distribution box firmly on the wall using expansion bolts or embedded wood bricks for smaller boxes .
- o Ensure the box is level, flush with the wall, and free of gaps; coat contact areas with anti-corrosion paint if needed .

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- o Use plastic ties to bind wires neatly, maintaining uniform spacing and straight runs .
- o Clearly label circuits and voltage levels inside the box.
- o Perform a safety inspection after wiring to check for short circuits, overloads, or loose connections .
