

Article Overview

A soft starter distribution box is wired by connecting the three-phase supply to the soft starter input, the motor to the output, and integrating the bypass contactor and control terminals according to the manufacturer's specifications.

Main Circuit Wiring

- o Three-Phase Power Input: Connect the incoming three-phase supply lines (L1, L2, L3) to the input terminals of the soft starter. Ensure proper phase sequence to avoid motor rotation issues .
- o Motor Output: Connect the motor terminals to the output side of the soft starter. This allows the soft starter to gradually ramp up voltage and limit inrush current during startup .
- o Bypass Contactor: Most soft starters include a bypass contactor either externally or built-in. Wire the bypass contactor in parallel with the soft starter so that once the motor reaches full speed, the contactor closes and the motor runs directly from the supply, bypassing the SCRs to reduce heat and losses .

Control and Auxiliary Wiring

Soft starters typically have multiple auxiliary terminals for control and monitoring:

- o Bypass Output (Terminals (1)(2)): Normally open contacts that close when the motor reaches full speed to activate the bypass contactor. Rated AC 250V/5A .
- o Programmable Relay Output (Terminals (3)(4)): Can be configured for delayed or conditional outputs. Normally open, AC 250V/5A .
- o Fault Output (Terminals (5)(6)): Closes when a fault occurs or power is lost, AC 250V/0.3A .
- o Instantaneous Stop Input (Terminal (7)): Connect to terminal (10) for normal operation. Opening these terminals triggers a stop and fault protection. Can be controlled by external protection devices .
- o Analog Output (Terminals (8)(9)): DC 4-20mA output indicating real-time motor current .

Safety and Protection

- o Include a main circuit breaker (MCCB) or fuse upstream of the soft starter to protect against overcurrent .
- o Ensure proper grounding of the soft starter and motor.
- o Follow manufacturer-specific wiring diagrams for terminal labeling and control logic, as models may vary .

Wiring Tips

- o Verify all connections are tight and correctly rated for voltage and current.
- o Label all control and power wires for easier maintenance.

- o Test the soft starter in manual or test mode before full operation to ensure correct bypass and stop functions.
- o Avoid running the motor through the soft starter continuously at full load; use the bypass contactor to reduce thermal stress . By following these steps, the soft starter distribution box will safely control motor startup, reduce inrush current, and provide proper monitoring and protection.
